National dues will be \$46.50 a month, State dues \$75.00 a month (includes free enterprise \$15.00), and local dues \$83.50 per month, \$205.00 a month. Associate and Affiliate Members are \$195.00 a quarter.

Dues to PHCC-NA, PHCC-CA and PHCC-local are not deductible as a charitable contribution, but may be considered as an ordinary and necessary business expense. However, a portion of PHCC-NA and PHCC-CA dues is not deductible as a business expense to the extent that PHCC-NA and PHCC-CA engages in lobbying. The non-deductible portion of dues for 2014-2015 is five percent (5%).
